
FOOD PANTRY

Join us for a 4-week Advent study of Magrey R. DeVega's *The Christmas Letters*. The letters in the New Testament, known as the Epistles, contain the first attempts by the church to understand and celebrate the mystery of the Incarnation. They point us to the origins of what we believe about Jesus, fully human and fully divine. As we read from Romans, 1 John, Philippians, and Colossians, we will find within the texts an invitation from God to deepen our understanding of the Incarnation and embrace a fuller commitment to Jesus Christ. November is National Diabetes Awareness Month — a time to shine a light on awareness, prevention and the power of early detection. As a valued Blood Program Leader, your partnership plays a vital role in supporting both patients and donors in your community. The American Red Cross is expanding its health offerings to include hemoglobin A1C testing on successful donations in November (one test result per donor in a 12-month period). The A1C test is a simple, no-fasting needed screening that helps detect prediabetes and diabetes by measuring average blood sugar levels over the past three months.
